PAROS 1770-1775

After the Orlov incident and the destruction of the Ottoman fleet at the naval battle of Chesme, the Russians created a naval base of the Aegean and the Eastern Mediterranean in the bay of Naoussa, and established the Russian Principality of the Archipelago, with Paros as its administrative center.
